

SCHOOL LOTTERY RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the school lottery is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

RULES

1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st and 2nd prize.
3. The prizes will total £60. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of £50, 2nd prize of £10. *subject to ticket sales
4. If minimum ticket sales are not achieved, prize money will be distributed as 1st prize 25% of total monthly ticket sales and 2nd prize 10% of total monthly ticket sales.
5. The school lottery is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of St Augustine's School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
6. Numbers are limited to four per household.
7. Payments must be made by cheque or cash.
8. The draw shall be made on the last Friday of the month in the school reception.
9. The prize winnings will be distributed in cash either directly to you on the playground or to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
10. A signature will be required to confirm receipt of prize winnings.
11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and on the school website.
12. The school lottery will be run by the PA. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
13. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PA funds after six months.
