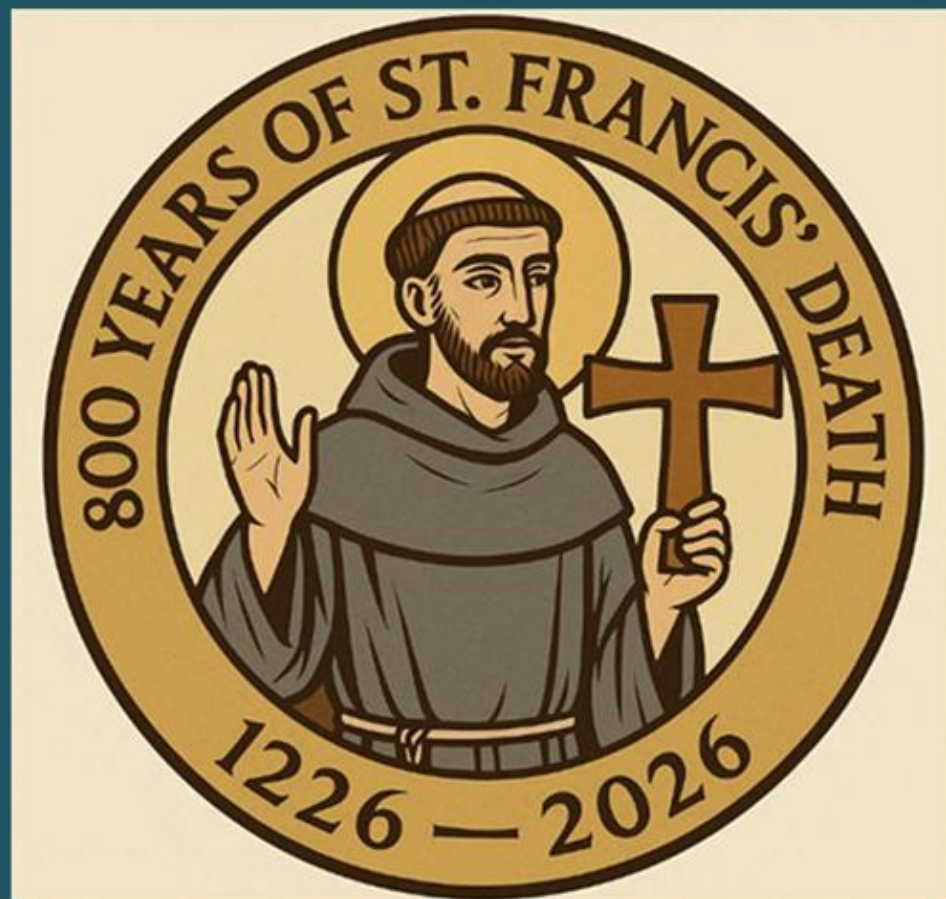

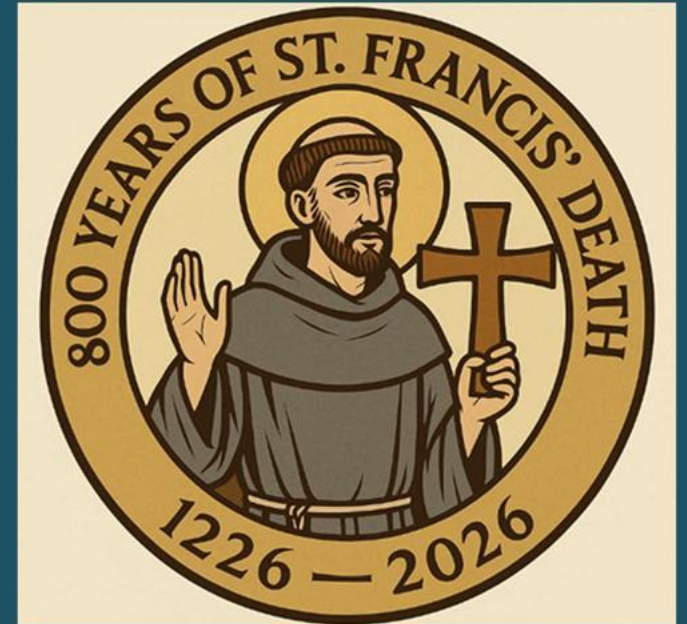
The Year of St. Francis
