Dear Parents/Guardians

Today, your child will come home with their end of year school reports – we have emphasised to the children that these reports are not to be opened in school or on the playground; they are addressed to the adults and to be viewed at home. Please find below further information about your child's school report.

## **Foundation Stage overview**

In Nursery, there will be a comment for RE and the three Prime areas of learning. For the remaining areas, there will be an overall effort grade and a general comment.

In Reception, there will be a comment for RE, Literacy and Maths. The other 5 remaining areas of learning will receive an effort grade and attainment grade along with a general comment. Children will have received a Good Level of Development (GLD) if they are on track for 5/7 areas. The two areas not required as part of GLD are Expressive Arts & Design and Understanding the World. Children will receive either of the following grades:

- WTS – your child is working towards the standard
- OT – your child is 'on track' and therefore has met the National standard expected for this area.

## **Years 1-6 overview**

Your child's school report will detail an effort grade for all subject areas and a Teacher Assessment for RE, English, Maths and Science. Year 1 will receive their Phonics results (32 is the pass mark) and Year 4 will receive their Multiplication Tables Check results (there is no pass mark). Attainment is not graded in non-core subjects and there is no longer Greater depth level for Science. The class teacher uses the results of recent tests, along with evidence they have seen in the classroom, to make an overall judgement about your child's progress and attainment. This is called a Teacher Assessment. The Teacher Assessment codes are as follows:

- WTS: Working towards the expected standard
- EXS: Working at the expected standard
- GDS: Working at greater depth within the expected standard

## **Key Stage 1 & Key Stage 2**

In May, Year 6 pupils took their Key Stage 2 Statutory Assessment Tests, also known as SATs. These papers are externally marked and results are sent to schools. Year 6 will have a print out of their scaled scores and a description to indicate the over standard achieved.

- 100 scaled score and above is when a child reaches the expected standard
- 110 scaled score and above is when a child reaches a greater depth standard

This academic year, Year 2 took part in 'optional' SATs in June. No test results/standardised scores are issued for Year 2, the tests are simply used to support the teacher when they are making their end of year teacher assessment judgements. Teachers assess against a clearly defined framework which informs the children's overall achievement. Do not worry if your child is not working at the expected standard. It is important to remember that these results will help teachers identify where your child may need extra help. Information has been shared with new teachers and with secondary schools to aid with transition.





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## School Performance

The tables below will allow you to compare your child's end of Phase performance with the attainment of other pupils in our school this year, and across England in 2024. The current National figures are 'Provisional' 2024.

We are above National for 4 consecutive years of data submission (against 2019, 2022, 2023 & 2024 data), in all areas of the school; indicating the positive impact that quality first teaching, interventions and tuition have had on all classes.

Thank you to all of our staff for making this possible due to their incredible hard work and commitment across the year. We have had successes in many areas including; a good Ofsted inspection in October 2023, LiveSimply Award, Gold History Quality Mark, Gold School Games Award and Greener Schools Award. A busy year!
