**Father Dominic writes:** Father Joseph, Deacon Kevin and I ask for your prayerful support in contacting your MP asking him/her to vote against the assisted dying bill. There are postcards available in the pews which you are welcome to use and to send to your MP as soon as possible.

**Archbishop Bernard** has forwarded some helpful information resources on the 'Assisted Suicide Bill' which has been introduced before Parliament. It is to be found at [www.cbcew.org.uk/opposing-assisted-suicide](http://www.cbcew.org.uk/opposing-assisted-suicide). Archbishop Bernard writes: 'It is important not to overlook the impact that a personal letter can have on the understanding and attitude of our members of Parliament, particularly if people feel able to refer to their own experience.' There are also posters in Church with QR codes which will help contacting our MP to ask them to stop assisted suicide being rushed into law. Cardinal Vincent has also produced a very helpful Pastoral letter which is available in both porches.
