This **Sunday, 7 September**, Blessed Carlo Acutis will be the first Millennial Saint to be canonised. He will be canonised alongside Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. Carlo was just 15 when he died. His legacy lives on, and he is a worldwide source of inspiration to many, especially young people.
