Dear Parent/Guardian

I am writing to provide you with an update to the **Enrichment Fund 2024/25 spend**. It was used to purchase an **Interactive whiteboard** for the Sunshine room and enabled the completion of the **School Library**. This learning environment has a **stunning mural**, with **new tables, chairs, cozy seating and floor cushions**, along with a new **Interactive whiteboard**. The target for our library, has now been met:

- promoting reading for pleasure for all children
- enabling research skills
- providing a wide range of books for all ages
- supporting and enhancing the school's curriculum
- providing a further teaching and learning space within school

We thank you all so much for your donations. Last year, the total donated was **£3636.40**, which was an increase of £300 from the previous year. Other funding from school (Capital funding, which can only be used towards IT infrastructure, building projects or furniture) was used to ensure these projects could be finished. The final purchase were new chairs for each classroom in Years 1-6...which we know the children were really excited about receiving!

Our main projects for 2025/26 Academic year are to raise funds to:

- Purchase further pupil laptops/ipad upgrades (working alongside the PA for this project)
- Creating a new class prayer space (working with our GIFT Chaplaincy Team)

We know how generous our families are and it would be incredible if every family was able to make donation. It is a total of £60 per family (Years 1-6), not per child. This amount will appear on your ParentPay account under the eldest child's name as £60, enabling you to pay in one go or to pay £20 termly, or £5 monthly.

Our other income stream is the **Foundation Stage Fund** – where all families contribute to this to help to replenish perishable items and buy cooking materials for the children to learn with within Nursery and Reception. If you have not paid for this yet, please can you go onto ParentPay and make this contribution, so that we can continue to provide the best experiences for your children.

We are requesting for any family to cancel the Direct Debit to the School Building Fund (this goes into our Capital pot) and switch to making your donations to the Enrichment Fund via ParentPay, as it gives us more flexibility on how we can spend the income received. We are unable to cancel the Direct Debit on your behalf.

All money generated from the Enrichment Fund will go directly to school, with our main focus in buying further new pupil laptops/upgrading the ipads and creating a new class prayer space, which all children will benefit from and this will continue to improve the quality of education at St Augustine's. We thank you all in advance for **any contributions** that you can make.
