Dear Parent/Guardian

We are delighted that our pupils will be participating in the Young Voices Concert next week. This promises to be a memorable and enriching experience for all involved. On the day of the event, the children will depart from school in the afternoon by coach. They will have lunch at school as usual before leaving; a hot school meal can be ordered via Parentpay, or alternatively, pupils may bring a packed lunch from home.

If your child is not attending the concert, they can wear non-uniform and will be completing work in school when the class departs.

In preparation for the concert, each child should bring a small selection of snacks for the afternoon, along with a packed tea to replace their usual evening meal. They will also need to bring a water bottle and one additional drink. Please note that cans and fizzy drinks are not permitted. All food and drink should be packed in a small backpack or disposable bag that can fit comfortably under their seat, as a bag security check is carried out when entering the venue. Staff will carry children's medication (e.g., EpiPen, inhalers etc.).

There will be no opportunity for children to purchase food, drinks, or memorabilia at the venue, so it is essential that pupils come fully prepared.

Tickets have been issued to school electronically and will be assigned to parents in the coming days via the email address held on our system. Please ensure you have actioned the email issued on Monday, to ensure a smooth distribution of the tickets.

All children are to wear **black** leggings/tracksuit bottoms/jeans, along with a long-sleeved black or white top, when coming to school on Monday next week. They may also wear an extra layer such as a jumper or cardigan for warmth. Please ensure that your child brings a coat on the day, as the venue can be quite cold and they will also be walking through the car park before and after the concert.

At the venue, children will receive their special torch and Young Voices T-shirt to wear over their long-sleeved top. **For children who have not pre-ordered a T-shirt, please ensure they bring their own plain white T-shirt. No torches from home are permitted**, as the ones provided are specially designed to prevent glare on the performers on stage.

**All children attending the concert will need to be picked up from school at 9:20/9:30pm.**

Due to the late finish, children may start school later on Tuesday, 13th January, if needed. They can either arrive at the **normal time or at 10:00am**. Please note that we only have one member of staff in the office, so other arrival times cannot be accommodated. The gate will be open at 9:55am for a 10am arrival at school.

We look forward to sharing this exciting occasion with our pupils and thank you for your support in ensuring they are ready for the day. We hope you and your child have a wonderful evening.
