**Father Dominic writes:** 'Christ is our resurrection and our life. When we are dead through sin Christ brings us his Spirit so that we may truly live the new life of grace. We are the spiritual brothers and sisters of Christ through God's Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead.' (Pope Saint John Sunday Missal.)

**Dear Parishioners: Deacon Kevin and I,** pray that we will all find renewed strength to continue our Lenten resolutions, as we begin these two weeks, known as Passiontide. The Archbishop has written a pastoral letter for this weekend. There are copies in both porches.

**Please pray for** all who are under instruction in order to be Received into the Church, including Yvonne Harris who will be baptised and received into Full Communion at the Easter Vigil. The next baptismal preparation evening will take place on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> April between 7.30pm-9.pm in the Presbytery. Please inform Mrs Mary Clark or one of the Clergy, if you wish to attend.

**We wish** to confirm the arrangements for Father Joseph's Funeral. Father will be Received into Church on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> March at 7pm; and Mass will follow his Reception. At **8.30pm** Funeral Liturgy (Oppees) -Mar Joseph Srampickal ( Bishop of the Syro Malabar Eparchy of Great Britain)

His Requiem will take place on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March at 12.00 midday. Bishop David Evans will be the leading celebrant for the Requiem. We have requested free car parking in the lower level of the Dominion Car Park in Herbert Road for both of these funeral liturgies. We would appreciate if you were willing to provide some food for the refreshments after the Requiem Mass on Wednesday. There is a list on the top of the piety stall in the main porch. Please sign the list indicating what food items you will bring. After the Funeral Mass on Wednesday, Father will remain in Church until 4.30pm. We have requested that Parishioners would remain in Church for half hour periods; a rota is available in the main porch for people to sign.

**On Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March,** we welcome St Peter's Sixth Form for Mass at 10am. All are welcome. After Mass, we will expose the Blessed Sacrament, until 5.45pm, when we will have Stations of the Cross, followed by Mass at 6.30pm. The main focus for prayer is to pray for peace in the world. There is a list in the main porch for you to sign, indicating which half hour you are available to Watch before the Blessed Sacrament.

**We have produced** some special sheet detailing the times of the Holy Week Services. There is also a list for Readers and Special Ministers of the Eucharist to sign to indicate your availability.

**Monsignor Danny's** sister, Gerladine, who has recently died, will have a Funeral at St George and St Teresa's, Dorridge on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March at 10.30am. She will be received into the Church on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March at 6.30pm.

**The Lenten Penance Service** will take place on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March at 7pm, at Olton Friary Church. Please note that there will not be 'Lectio Divina' this week on Wednesday; but there be a Prayer Meeting on Thursday.

**Stations of the Cross** will take place on a Wednesday before the midday Mass at 11.30am and on a Friday before the 6.30pm Mass. The schedule for Friday will be: Exposition from 5pm until 5.45pm followed by Stations, followed by 6.30pm Mass.
