## Year 6 School Trip – Warwick Castle

To support the Year 6 History and Geography curriculum this term, we will be taking the children to Warwick Castle for a day of Geography fieldwork and a History workshop. The trip will take place on **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April 2026**. The children will travel by coach (with seat belts) leaving school at 9:20 and returning for the end of the school day.

Part of our curriculum enrichment over the academic year involves trips off site and visitors into school. Please be aware that we have varying costs related to enrichment opportunities; some are free, some will be lower costs due to having a special visitor in school and others may be more expensive linked to travel and entry costs. We try our best to vary the experiences and opportunities for children across the school. Please note, with lower funding in schools, we are not able to subsidise as much as we used to. Therefore, if we do not receive sufficient financial support for these events, future activities/trips will need to be cancelled. We thank you in advance for your support with this.

A contribution of **£19.50** is required to help cover entrance fee to the castle, a workshop and the coach fare. Consent and payment for the trip should be made through ParentPay as soon as possible. If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium Funding, there will be no charge on ParentPay. If you have any financial difficulty with this trip, please speak to a member of the office staff.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch, they can bring their lunch boxes but will need to take responsibility for looking after it and carrying it across the course of the day. School packed lunches are available to order please order a sandwich option via Parentpay. Please note school lunches need to be ordered in advance and no later than **Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> April**, we cannot accept orders the night before or morning of the trip as the school kitchen will not be open before the children leave school. All children will need to bring a drink to have with their lunch and their water bottle. No cans or glass bottles please.

Children are required to wear their PE kits and school hoodie, but ensure they also have weather appropriate clothing e.g. sunhat/suncream or raincoats and warm clothing. In addition, they will need to bring (in a small rucksack) appropriate footwear for fieldwork dependent on the weather ie wellies/boots or trainers.

To facilitate this trip we will need 3 parental volunteers to accompany us. Please indicate on the Parentpay consent form if you are able to help and we will confirm as soon as possible if your support is needed.
