EYFS Trip to Ash End House Children's Farm

As part of our learning about traditional tales, we have arranged for the Nursery and Reception classes to go to Ash End House Children's Farm, Middleton, Near Tamworth for a Farm Tales Tour. The trip will take place on **Wednesday 17th June 2026**. The children will travel by coach (with seat belts) leaving school at 9:20am and will arrive back to school for the end of the school day.

A contribution of **£22.90** is required to help cover entrance fee, farm tour and coach fare. If your child is entitled to Early Years Pupil Premium Funding, there will be no charge for this trip. Consent and payment for the trip should be made through Parentpay as soon as possible. Children should wear non uniform (own clothes) suitable for the weather and for a farm tour.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch, packed in a named carrier bag for ease of disposal, please do not send lunchboxes. As all children in Reception are entitled to a Universal Infant free school meal, the kitchen can provide a free packed lunch. School packed lunches are available to order through Parentpay – please choose the sandwich option and Mrs Morrissey, our cook will make it into a packed lunch with crudities, fruit and a cake. Lunches need to be preordered by Monday 15th June at the latest. All children will need to bring a drink - but no cans or glass bottles please. Nursery children should bring their own packed lunch as normal.

To facilitate this trip we will require some parental volunteers to accompany us, please indicate on the consent form on Parentpay if you are able to help and we will confirm as soon as possible if your support is needed. Thank you in advance for your support.

If any of your details have changed since completion of the blue trip Consent Form please send up-to-date details into school prior to the trip. Please contact school if you have any concerns. Many thanks.
