Dear Parent/Guardian

As part of our PE curriculum delivery, we have been participating in Cricket sessions provided by Warwickshire Cricket Board. Due to overlapping commitments we did not think the Year 5's would be able to participate in the festival. However, a late opportunity has arisen and we now have the opportunity to take part in the 'Chance to Shine' Cricket Festival, which will take place on **Tuesday 16th June from 10:00am to 2:00pm**. The festival will take place at **Hampton and Solihull Cricket Club, Marsh Lane, Solihull**. Therefore, we will be using a coach for the event.

The children will need to be dressed in PE kit for the festival and prepared for wet (rain jacket) or sunny weather (school cap and sun-cream).

The children will need to bring a packed lunch, they can bring their lunch boxes but will need to take responsibility for looking after it and carrying it across the course of the day, alternatively they may wish to bring their lunch in a named carrier bag for ease of disposal. School packed lunches are available to order via Parentpay, please order a sandwich option and Mrs Morrissey will make this into a packed lunch with crudites, fruit and a cake, you may wish to supplement this with additional snacks for the day. Please note school lunches need to be ordered in advance and no later than **Thursday 11th June**. We cannot accept orders the night before or morning of the trip as the school kitchen will not be open before the children leave school.

All children will need to bring a bottle of water, a drink for lunchtime and other snacks that will sustain them throughout the day (no nuts).

We also require the support of **three** parent helpers to accompany us to the event. Please note that parent helpers may be required to assist with scoring the Cricket matches throughout the day. However, the format is simpler than a normal Cricket match and full support and advice will be given in advance of the festival commencing.

If you are in a position to help out, please let Mrs Welch or Mrs Spillane know at the earliest convenience. **We will be departing school at 9.30am and returning to school at approximately 2:30pm.**
