Year 4 Chance to Shine Cricket Festival

Dear Parent/Guardian

As part of our PE curriculum delivery, we have been participating in Cricket sessions provided by Warwickshire Cricket Board. These sessions conclude with participation in the 'Chance to Shine' Cricket Festival, which will take place on **Tuesday 30th June 10:00am to 2:00pm**. The festival will take place at Solihull and Blossomfield Cricket Club, therefore, we will be walking from school to the event.

- **Intent of Festival:** For pupils to experience playing as part of a team in a cricket festival following a block of 6 lessons in curriculum; allowing them the opportunity to demonstrate skills they have learnt.
- **Compete Event:** Pupil's will play in competitive games with the outcome of the game focussing on the team winning with the most number of runs scored.
- **Engage Event:** Pupil's will play in competitive games however the outcome of the game will focus on the School Games Values – Teamwork & Respect, with schools accumulating points throughout their games.

The children will need to be dressed in PE kit for the Festival and prepared for wet (rain jacket) or sunny weather (school cap and sun-cream).

They will also need to bring a packed lunch with them or they can opt to have a packed lunch instead of a school dinner (this costs the same as a hot meal). School packed lunches are available to order, please order a sandwich option via Parentpay. Please note school lunches need to be ordered in advance and **no later than Tuesday 23rd June**, we cannot accept orders the night before or morning of the trip.

All children will need to bring a bottle of water, a drink for lunchtime and other snacks that will sustain them throughout the day.

We also require the support of **three** parent helpers to accompany us to the event. Please note that parent helpers will be required to assist with scoring the Cricket matches throughout the day. However, the format is simpler than a normal Cricket match and full support and advice will be given in advance of the festival commencing. Unfortunately, there are **no** spectators allowed this year.

If you are able to help, please can you let school know at your earliest convenience.
