Reception Baseline

The Reception Baseline assessment (RBA), is a short, interactive and practical assessment of your child's early Literacy, Communication, Language and Mathematics skills when they begin in school. It will be undertaken with myself or Miss Harwood during the first weeks in school and will measure your child's progress from Reception to Year 6. The results will not be shared with the school, the teachers or you as parent/guardian as the data will only be shared with the DfE. We always spend quality time 1 to 1 with your child, getting to know them at the beginning of the year so this assessment will just aid this. Pupils will not be told it is a test/assessment and will just be asked a series of questions and have access to resources. When your child reaches Year 6, you will be able to see the progress your child has made throughout their school journey. If you wish to read any further information about the Reception Baseline, we have attached a parent booklet for you to read.
