**Year 3 Heritage Learning on-site visit - 'Stone Age to Iron Age'**

Year Three's Autumn One Term History topic is: **Stone Age to Iron Age** 'What was life like for the first people in Britain and how do we know?'

To support the curriculum this term, we have arranged for Heritage Learning to visit us in school and present a workshop all about this period in time on **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2026**.

The visit takes the children on an exciting story world adventure in an 'electronic game' where they must prove their knowledge of each level (Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age) to progress in the game. Children will explore what people ate, the homes they lived in, the tools they used and the skills they deployed in each era. This workshop includes many activities that allow students to handle original and replica objects from the Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age and engage in activities in role as game players.

Part of our curriculum enrichment over the academic year involves trips off site and visitors into school. Please be aware that we have varying costs related to enrichment opportunities; some are free, some will be lower costs due to having a special visitor in school and others may be more expensive linked to travel and entry costs. We try our best to vary the experiences and opportunities for children across the school. Please note, with lower funding in schools, we are not able to subsidise as much as we used to. Therefore, if we do not receive sufficient financial support for these events, future activities/trips will need to be cancelled. We thank you in advance for your support with this.

On this occasion, we have a visitor coming to school from Heritage to support the Year 3 children and their History learning.

A contribution of **£10 per child** is required to help cover the cost of the visitor and the children's workshop day. If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium Funding, there will be no charge on ParentPay. Please provide permission by Parentpay for your child to be involved in the workshop, and if requested, to make the relevant payment through ParentPay by **Friday 25<sup>th</sup> September**.
